The Kenosha Joint Services Board meeting was **Called to Order** at 4:30 p.m. by Chairman Jeffrey Gentz in Joint Services Training Room located in the Kenosha County Public Safety Building.

Under, **2022 Budget**, Assistant Director Josh Nielsen presented and explained each of the 2022 budget drafts to the Board for consideration.

Tim Bever of the Johnson Financial Group spoke regarding the renewal notice from WCA health insurance and reported that the renewal came in at a 5.5% increase over the previous year.

Assistant Director Nielsen presented the 2022 budget draft 3 which includes the health insurance increase of 5.5%, a 2% across the board increase and a shift up in salary grades for Telecommunicators and Communications Supervisors by one grade. A brief discussion ensued.

Mr. Morrissey made a motion to approve the 2022 budget as presented in draft 3 and Ms. Yuhas seconded the motion. On a roll call vote, motion passed unanimously.
